Haggai chapter 2

In verses 2-9, is God complaining that the temple the people have worked hard on for the past month is not good enough for Him? or is He encouraging them to keep going even though it doesn't look all that great so far? Is He concerned about having a glorious place in which to dwell, or that His people are tired, frightened, and discouraged?

Did the people of Haggai's day see (produce) a restored temple that matched these descriptions: "I will fill this house with glory" [7] and "in this place I will give peace" [9]?

Two more months go by, and God sends another message to His people; what does he tell them? [14-19] Is it *possible* to please god?
